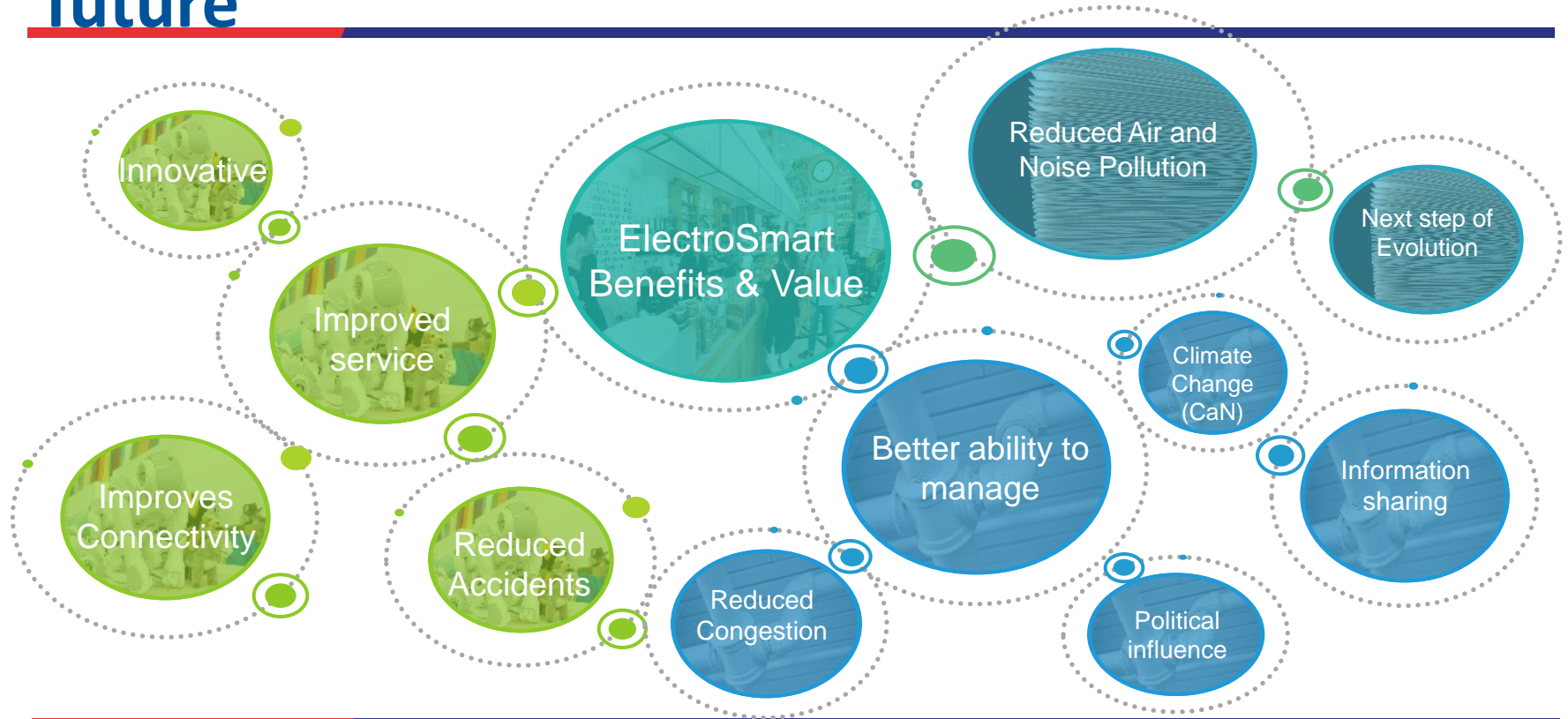

Improve quality of life and wellbeing by creating open spaces to improve air and noise quality & promotes cycling and walking.

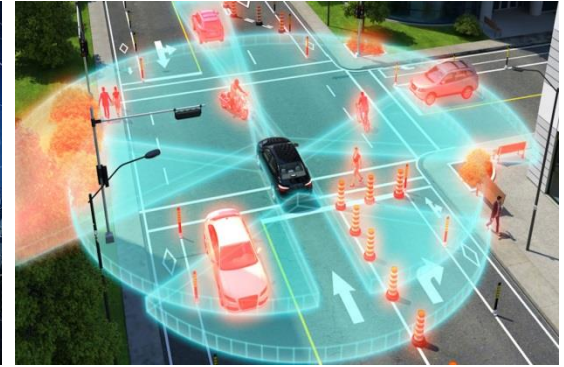
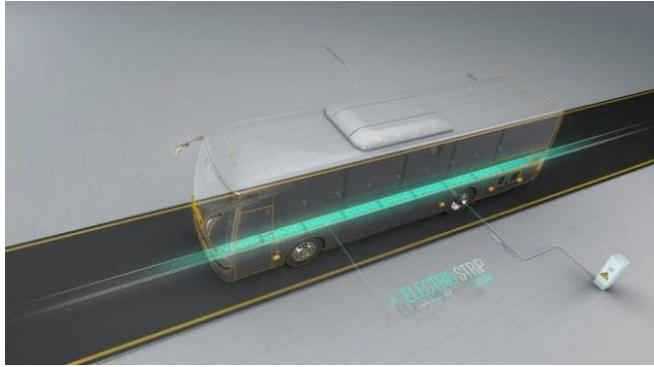


Enhance the natural and built environment, creating a safer space, where greenery can be placed attracting wildlife. The built environment will change as roads are changed.
